- STEP 1: **COMPLETE** all fields on this form. This form is to facilitate and expedite the processing of your public records request. Describe identifiable records in the possession of the City; your request must be sufficiently focused and specific to allow the City to locate the requested record(s).
- STEP 2: **SUBMIT** completed form by mail, fax, email or in person to Custodian of Records, Office of the City Clerk, 200 S. Anaheim Blvd. (714) 765-5166; [landal@anaheim.net](mailto:landal@anaheim.net) fax: (714) 765-4105
- STEP 3: **WAIT** to receive an invoice for responsive records. The City shall determine within 10-days from receipt of a public records request, whether the request, in whole or in part, seeks copies of discloseable public records in possession of the City [GC 6253(c)]. Please note that if you are requesting the opportunity to inspect records, you will be requested to make an appointment to return at a later date/time to view the documents.

Charges for the direct cost of duplication will apply. **Documents will not be copied until payment has been received.** If payment is not received within 10 days after invoice is sent, you may be required to submit a new request. Please see backside for additional information.

### DESCRIPTION OF REQUESTED RECORD(S): (Describe the specific public record(s) e.g., date, type, time period covering documents requested etc)

1. A log of all disciplinary action against Anaheim Police Department's officers for the last 10 years, including all fields that are publicly releasable. If available, the fields we request include but aren't limited to the name of the officer, the case number, the date of the incident, a summary of the incident, the final outcome and the disciplinary action if any. We are simply looking for a list that can be condensed into an excel document or similar spreadsheet that demonstrates APD keeps track of disciplinary action given to its officers. We do not need any private personnel information that would be exempt under §6254(c). We do not need any police investigatory records or individual case files. These records are not exempt under §6255 because there is no logical public interest to be served by not disclosing the information we are requesting. The same argument applies to the Official Information Privilege [Evidence Code §§1040(b)]. If the city claims exemption under [Evidence Code §§1040(b)] or Government Code §6255 we would like a written explanation that documents the reason why the release of this record is a disservice to the public interest.
2. A log of commendations issued to police officers, including all and any fields that are publicly releasable. We are simply looking for a list of commendations handed out to police officers, along with their names and the date of the commendation that covers the past ten years. We do not need any private personnel information that would be exempt under §6254(c). We do not need any police investigatory records or individual case files. These records are not exempt under §6255 because there is no logical public interest to be served by not disclosing the information we are requesting. The same argument applies to the Official Information Privilege [Evidence Code §§1040(b)].

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### DESCRIPTION OF REQUESTED RECORD(S)-Continuation

*If the city claims exemption under [Evidence Code §§1040(b)] or Government Code §6255 we would like a written explanation that documents the reason why the release of this record is a disservice to the public interest.*

*3. A log of payments related to legal settlements, pre-litigation decisions and jury verdicts for the last 10 years involving the police department and/or its officers, including all fields that are publicly releasable. I filed a public document request for this document several weeks ago and received almost what I was looking for, but it did not contain the date each case was settled. If possible, I would like to also have the date the case was settled on this document.*

*4. A log of any independent or civilian review board sustained case files, including all fields that are publicly releasable. If available, the fields we request include but aren't limited to officer name, incident date, log/C.R. No., notification date, location, complaint, summary and finding. These are not police investigatory records, they are civilian review board records, so they cannot not exempt under disclosure under Government Code § 6254(f). Like all my other requests, we simply want an excel file or similar spreadsheet that acknowledges that Anaheim's Civilian Review Board keeps track of its investigations. The requested list of information does not include any private personnel information that would be exempt under Government Code §6254(c). These records are not exempt under §6255 because there is no logical public interest to be served by not disclosing the information we are requesting. The same argument applies to the Official Information Privilege [Evidence Code §§1040(b)]. If the city claims exemption under [Evidence Code §§1040(b)] or Government Code §6255 we would like a written explanation that documents the reason why the release of this record is a disservice to the public interest.*
