

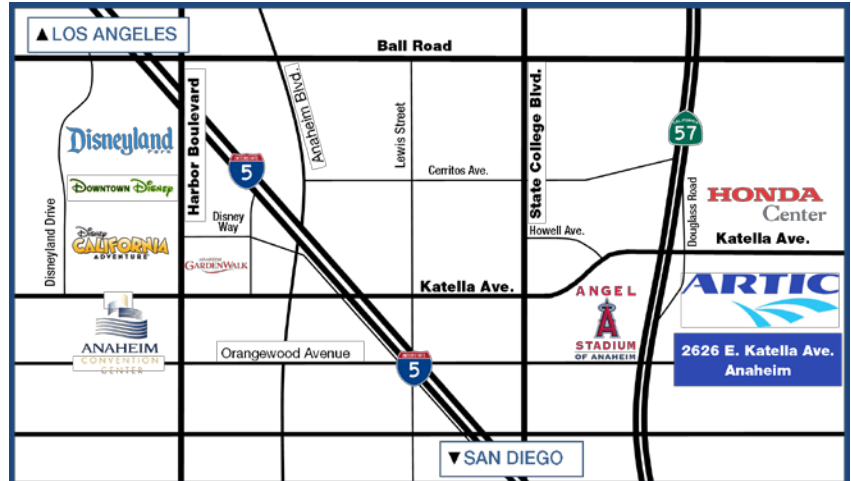


Fact Sheet



Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center

- **What:** transportation center for trains, buses, shuttles, taxis and bikes serving daily commuters, visitors, leisure travelers, local and regional bus passengers
- **Where:** 2626 E. Katella Ave., next to Angel Stadium of Anaheim and across from Honda Center
- **Opened:** Dec. 6, 2014
- **Owner:** city of Anaheim
- **Property manager:** Anaheim Transportation Center Management, part of Anaheim Arena Management, operator of Honda Center
- **Transition:** in July 2019, Anaheim Transportation Center Management took over running ARTIC for the city of Anaheim as part of a larger agreement extending management of Honda Center, the Anaheim Ducks and the sale of city land around the arena

- **Ridership:**
 - **2017 event day:** 5,199 ○ **2017 weekday:** 4,364
 - **2015 event day:** 3,878 ○ **2015 weekday:** 2,406
- **Ridership surveys:** conducted in May and June 2017 and June and July 2015 by Anaheim-based DKS Associates
- **Survey methodology:** Each use of a train, bus or other transit service is counted as one trip, in accordance with the industry standard set by the American Public Transportation Association and National Transit Database requirements set by the federal government
- **Train:**
 - Two platforms, northbound and southbound
 - AMTRAK regional and national service
 - Metrolink Southern California service
- **Bus:**
 - 15 bus bays
 - OCTA service in Orange County
 - Anaheim Resort Transportation service within Anaheim and visitor destinations in neighboring cities
 - Greyhound national service
 - Tres Estrellas de Oro service to Mexico
 - FlixBus service to Las Vegas, Bay Area, Phoenix
- **Taxi:** Yellow Cab Co.
- **Bikes:**
 - 24 covered bike lockers plus bike racks
 - Front bumper bike racks on OCTA and ART buses
 - Bikes allowed onboard AMTRAK and Metrolink trains
 - Located along the Santa Ana River Trail

ARTIC

- **Services:**
 - **Auntie Anne's/Pinkberry:** frozen yogurt and pretzel kiosk opened March 2017
 - **Upstairs restaurant space:** home to The Oyster Bar Steam Kettle Cooking from 2016 to early 2019; Anaheim Arena Management exploring operation and future options
 - **Downstairs market space:** home to Mission Market Express from 2014 to early 2019; new grab-and-go market expected in summer 2019
- **Parking:** 1,057 spaces in three surface lots, free for transit users
 - 435 spaces in Lot A short-term parking
 - 217 spaces in Lot B long-term parking
 - 405 spaces in Lot C employee and permit parking
- **Terminal:** 67,000 square feet
- **Roof:** 120 feet high with 200,000 square feet of arching panels and 1,354 colored lights
- **Filming:** ARTIC is regularly used for filming including television shows including "Marvel's Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D.," "True Detective" and "Ray Donovan" and commercials for Boeing, CNN and Audi
