# City of Anaheim Annual Registered Lobbyist Report 2018

### Registered Lobbyist Report: Calendar Year 2018

#### A. Background

On August 15, 2017, the City Council of the City of Anaheim adopted Ordinance No. 6417, which became effective on September 14, 2017. This ordinance includes a "Sunshine" provision which implemented the Lobbyist Registration Program. This program requires an individual or entity who receives compensation of \$500 or more in a calendar month for lobbying in the City of Anaheim or any regional agency in which Anaheim has a voting role to register with the City Clerk as a lobbyist.

To ensure complete public disclosure of the range of activities by and those who employ them, lobbying entities are required to file quarterly disclosure reports. Pursuant to Section 1.11.070.050 of the Anaheim Municipal Code, an Annual Report is submitted to City Council outlining lobbyist activity and a list of any fines assessed. This report summarizes the lobbyist activity as disclosed in reports filed for Quarters 1, 2, 3 and 4 of calendar year 2018.

#### B. Registration

Lobbyists and Lobbying Firms are required to register with the City Clerk within fifteen (15) days of Lobbying the City of Anaheim or any regional agency in which Anaheim has a voting role.

During calendar year 2018, seven (7) firms registered a total of twelve (12) individual lobbyists, representing twelve (12) clients. The lobbyist which registered in 2018 are as follows:

#### E. Notice (s) of Registration Required Issued

Pursuant Section 1.11.070.070 of the Anaheim Municipal Code, the City Clerk shall issue a "Notice of Registration Required" upon the written request of 1) the City Council or any of its members, 2) any board or commission pursuant to a majority vote of its total membership, or 3) any officer or employee of the City charged by law with conducting a hearing and making a decision on a matter pending or proposed.

During calendar year 2018, a "Notice of Registration Required" was issued to Lou Penrose on May 21, 2018; response to notice received on June 5, 2018; no further action was needed.
