RE: ORDER NO. 14 – ECONOMIC RECOVERY PLAN

As part of its adoption of the Anaheim Economic Recovery Plan at its March 26, 2020 meeting, the City Council authorized the City Manager to utilize a variety of programs, policies and practices to help the City navigate through the unprecedented challenges of the COVID-19 crisis, and to position the City for a successful recovery following the crisis. To provide transparency to the actions of the City Manager while exercising the authority approved by Council, decisions of the City Manager will be documented through “Order(s) of the City Manager of the City of Anaheim in Furtherance of the Anaheim Economic Recovery Plan,” and will be forwarded to Council and made publicly available on the City website.

Attached is Order No. 14 of the City Manager. This Order extends previous Orders that were set to expire on January 3, 2022, which provide regulatory relief for businesses re-opening under the Governor’s Blueprint for a Safer Economy, including waiver of special event permit requirements for outdoor dining, displays and activities, waiver of temporary banners and flags requirements, and waiver of permit and inspection fees ordinarily imposed for canopies and tents and associated ancillary equipment, such as generators. This Order extends provisions of Executive Order No. 13 related to Special Event Permit Requirements to Thursday, March 31, 2022, and provisions relating to Outdoor Dining Standards and certain fees charged for canopies, tents, and associated ancillary equipment to Friday, July 15, 2022, or until expressly repealed or superseded by a duly enacted ordinance of the City Council or by further Order of the City Manager.

City staff continues to actively evaluate necessary actions (“Orders”) in furtherance of the City Council’s direction on March 26, 2020, which will be provided to the City Council and posted on the City’s website as soon as they are available.
