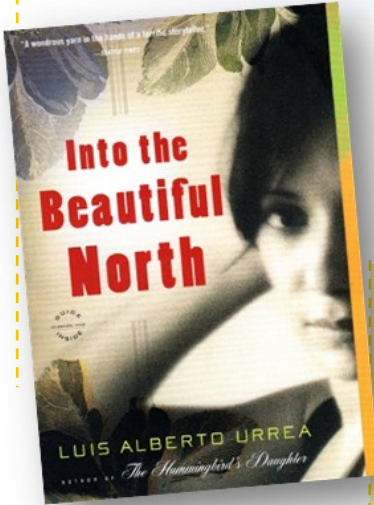

### Indie Author Day at Central Library

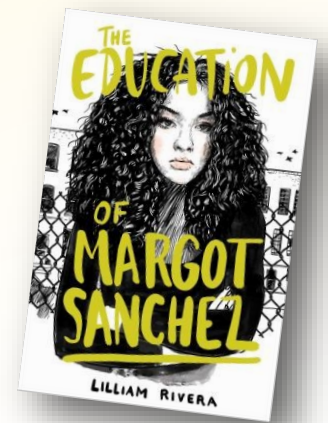
**Saturday, October 14 from 1:00 to 4:00pm**
