This is a follow-up letter to my June 23, 2015 letter. I have enclosed a copy for your reference. Based on my original request, dated March 17, 2015, you did not provide any ~~information on settlements or really any information~~ <sup>documents</sup> on who sued; nonetheless, I would like to ask for documents such as complaints, judgments and settlements, as I am trying to get a handle on what civil rights cases are costing society.

I also wanted <sup>documents related to</sup> statistical information regarding use of force. Enclosed is my letter dated May 5, 2015. I would like to know if there is any documentation regarding Use of Force Statistics. Doesn't the department keep any statistics on use of force? Isn't there any tracking of the use of force from an institutional point of view? Isn't there something that could show trends, norms or out of normal use?

Regarding documents that were sent to me regarding Acevedo v. City of Anaheim, et al. and Diaz v. City of Anaheim, I would be interested in obtaining any documents available pertaining to complaints, judgments and settlement amounts and total amounts of those lawsuits.

I am once again asking: Please tell me what documents you have. You are required to affirmatively help ascertain as to what documents are available.

Thank you for writing. Sorry it has taken some time.

I see that the City is willing to provide the documents related to 2-5 (persons shot) and 11 (body cameras).

I also see that the city was sued twice - but I can not tell if the suits are successful or settled. At this point I do not need those complaints.

As to 6-9 regarding officers shot -- evidently there have been no officers shot during this time period, and therefore no records.

10: No documents as there are no Taser videos.

What about 12--stats on use of force? Are you saying that the department keeps NO statistics on the use of force by its officers -- or any documentation on which statistical analysis can be made? IS there any tracking of the use of force from an institutional point of view, something that could show trends, norms, out of norm use?

13: The Policy about those recorders. Will be provided?

I can not tell if the objections you have written mean that you are not giving me documents are just complaining that they may or may not run afoul of some law but are giving me the documents anyway. Can you tell me what you are not providing me?
