A letter was received concerning an investigation of Anaheim police misconduct dated July 30, 2015 from the Anaheim Police Department Internal Affairs LT Jung, and Division Commander CPT Hittesdorf. That letter used deceptive language and "half-truths" to imply that their investigation was completed, but failed to state their findings. Attempting to cover up Anaheim police misconduct (and violation of the CPRA) is criminal misconduct in itself.

On August 3, 2015, a CPRA request was made for copied of all related documents related to that Anaheim police misconduct investigation. Theonly reply to that request was a copy of a police report that referred to many other records.

On August24, 2015, the original CPRA request for all related records for that Anaheim police misconduct investigation was repeated ask for and also to include the records referred to in that police report. A reply letter to that request dated September 3, 2015 stated that all of the requested records (in their Entirety) were exempt from disclosure (an obvious falsehood). Therefore, please send the discription of each record that you are attempting to exempt in its entirety so your questionable exemptions can be challenged in court.

Please be advised that we have evidence (transcripts) that an Anaheim Police Department Assistant Chief orchestrated and directed criminal activities by five lower rank Anaheim police officers. This was the purpose of the police investigation. The further cover up in not releasing the requested CPRA records is most certainly also a criminal
