Notice of Removal of Existing Crosswalk Orangethorpe Avenue at Kellogg Drive South

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21950.5, notice is hereby given that the existing marked crosswalk located at the easterly leg of the intersection of Orangethorpe Avenue and Kellogg Drive South is to be removed. The limited existing public right-of-way, narrow sidewalk and conflicting utilities prohibit the installation of an ADA compliant curb ramp on the north side of the easterly leg of the intersection.

A new ADA compliant curb ramp will be installed at the northwest corner of the intersection of Orangethorpe Avenue and Kellogg Drive South. The existing marked crosswalk at the westerly leg of this intersection will remain and be restriped diagonally to align with the new ADA compliant curb ramp. The removal of the crosswalk and the new improvements are scheduled to be constructed in the summer of 2021 as part of the Orangethorpe Avenue Street Rehabilitation Improvements.
