That's why we've been working on options to make it easier for residents, employees and visitors to get around.

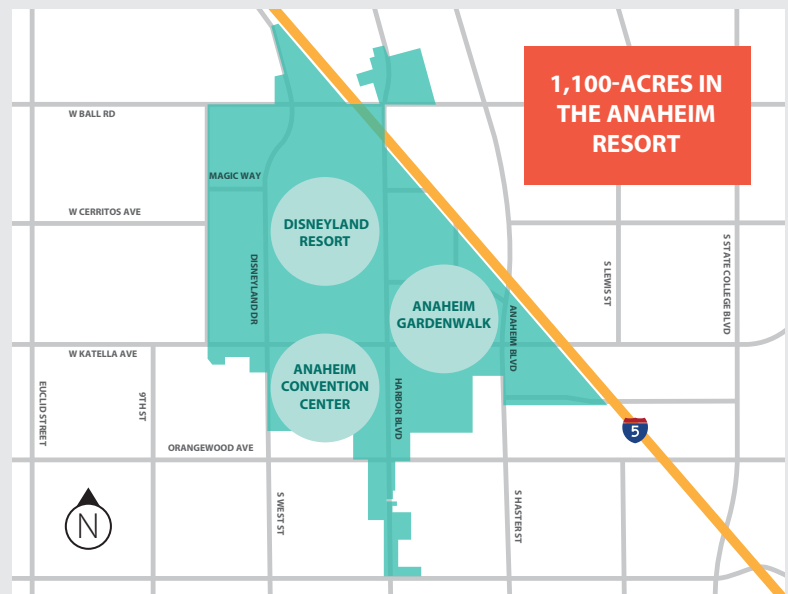

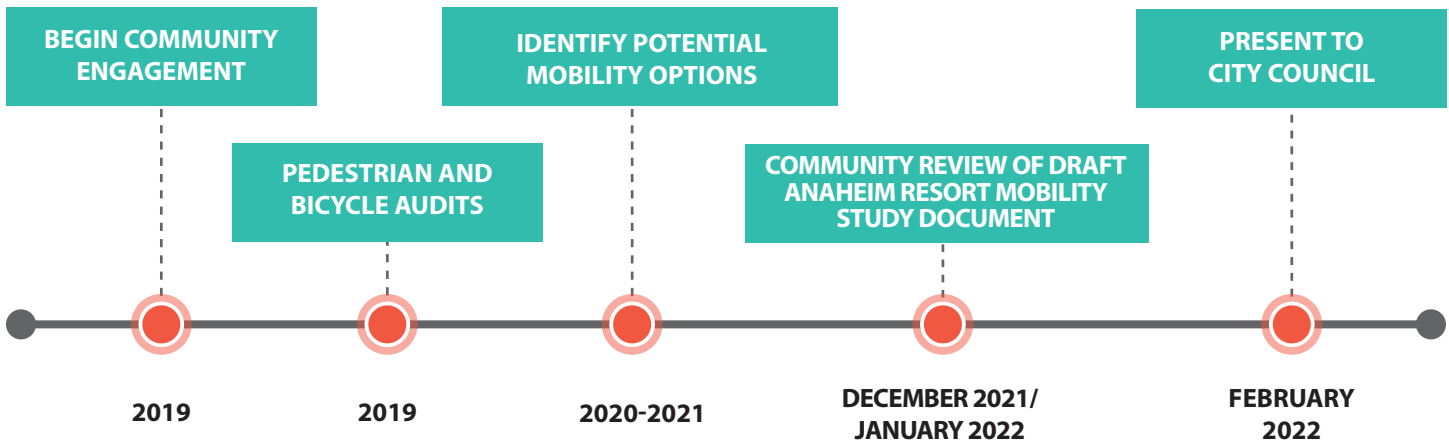
