*City Council public discussions, city staff updates and closed session hearings*

- **Jan. 15, 2019:** City Council hears public comment, discusses and votes to update lease with Angels Baseball
- **Feb. 19, 2019:** City Council considers and provides direction for city manager to enlist appraisal services for city land around Angel Stadium of Anaheim
- **March 5, 2019:** City Council hears update from then-City Manager Chris Zapata on hiring of appraiser for city land around the stadium
- **March 19, 2019:** City Council hears update from city manager on a March 18 meeting with the Angels that covered the team’s retaining of Brook Street as a real estate consultant
- **April 16, 2019:** City Council hears update from city manager about the city’s hiring of sports consultant Dan Barrett
- **May 7, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager about the status of the city-commissioned appraisal
- **May 14, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager on a request received by the city to meet with Angels Baseball
- **June 4, 2019:** City Council hears update from city manager on a May 20 meeting between the city and Angels Baseball, and that the team is focusing on Anaheim with the additional hiring of architectural, finance and engineering consultants
- **June 4, 2019:** Mayor Harry Sidhu calls for formation of city negotiating team including himself, then-City Manager Zapata and City Attorney Robert Fabela

*City Council public discussions, city staff updates and closed session hearings*

- **June 18, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager that there have been no additional meetings with Angels Baseball since May 20
- **July 16, 2019:** City Council votes to designate Mayor Harry Sidhu as the exclusive Council representative on the city negotiating team with the city manager and city attorney
- **July 16, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager that there have been no new developments and no additional meetings with Angels Baseball since May 20
- **July 30, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager that the city has received a draft of the commissioned appraisal for city land around the stadium and the City Council is set to be briefed on it in closed session on Aug. 13
- **Aug. 13, 2019:** City Council hears about draft appraisal for city land around the stadium in closed session
- **Aug. 13, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager on a July 31 meeting with Angels Baseball President John Carpino about current stadium issues; the city's hiring of real estate consultant Larry Kosmont; and that an initial negotiation meeting with the Angels is expected in October
- **Aug. 27, 2019:** City Council hears from the public and discusses potential negotiations considerations, reviews 1996 stadium lease
- **Sept. 9, 2019:** City Council hears update from the city manager on an expected City Council closed session appraisal update set for Sept. 24 and a Sept. 9 conversation with Angels President Carpino working toward a meeting in October
- **Sept. 24, 2019:** City Council hears update about appraisal for city land around the stadium in closed session; City Council reviews meeting minutes from Jan. 15, 2019, lease update
- **Oct. 29, 2019:** City Council tables agenda items on releasing stadium land appraisal, discussing review period for any negotiated agreement
