FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION

The **Fair Political Practices Commission** (FPPC) has primary responsibility for the impartial and effective administration of the Political Reform Act. The Act regulates campaign financing, conflicts of interest, lobbying, and governmental ethics. The Commission's objectives are to ensure that public officials act in a fair and unbiased manner in the governmental decision-making process, to promote transparency in government, and to foster public trust in the political system. The FPPC provides multiple tools to assist in learning about and complying with the Act, including manuals, fact sheets and guides, training and outreach, and technical advice
