WILLOWBROOK NEIGHBORHOOD RESIDENTIAL STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT JUNE 2022 — NOVEMBER 2022

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Willowbrook Residential Street Improvement Project will restore road surface integrity and improve the asphalt pavement. The work includes removal and reconstruction of damaged concrete sidewalks, curbs and gutters, driveway approaches and removal and reconstruction of ADA access ramps. This project will improve pedestrian mobility and beautify the neighborhood. This neighborhood is bordered by Gene Autry Way to the north, Lewis St to the east, Simmons Ave to the south, and Harbor Blvd to the west.

PROJECT STATISTICS

- ◆ 1,374,000 square feet of street improvements
- ◆ 25,000 square feet of sidewalk
- ◆ 10,000 linear feet of curb and gutter
- ◆ 26 ADA Access Ramps
- ◆ New pavement markings will be painted
- ◆ New street name signs will be installed

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where can I park my car(s) during construction?

On street parking will be available throughout construction within 800 feet of your home to the extent possible.

Will my trash be collected?

Yes. Your trash collection day will not be affected during construction.

Where can I park on street sweeping days?

You may park on surrounding streets within 800 feet of your home. Street sweeping parking citations will **NOT** be issued on surrounding streets within City of Anaheim limits while construction is in progress.

Will I have access to my driveway?

Yes. You will have access to your driveway throughout this project. Should it be necessary for your driveway to be temporarily blocked during construction activities, we will contact you prior to construction to coordinate access.

What is the duration of this project?

You will receive a construction notice at least one (1) week in advance. The notice will indicate the construction dates. Additionally, the City's website will have updated information regarding the construction schedule for your neighborhood.

What are the working hours?

Construction hours are typically from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; however, hours are subject to change.
