## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Anaheim Housing Authority began accepting pre-applications for the **Housing Choice Voucher**, also referred to as Section 8, program **waiting list** beginning **Monday, March 6, 2023 at 10 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. The closing date of the application period has been extended through Friday, April 14, 2023 at 4:59 p.m. Pacific Standard Time.** The Housing Choice Voucher program provides rental assistance to eligible low-income families, which helps them afford safe, quality housing.

The Anaheim Housing Authority will add up to 10,000 pre-applications to the waiting list. If more than 10,000 are received, veterans or those who live or work in Anaheim will be given a preference and placed on the waiting list first.

A lottery will be performed within each preference group to randomly determine placement order on the wait list, and if applicable, which pre-applications will be accepted to the waiting list. Please note, submitting a pre-application does not represent an offer for housing assistance or guarantee placement on any waiting list.

**Due to the extension of the waiting list opening, applicants will now be notified of their lottery selection status via email by May, 11, 2023.** After that date, applicants can check their status at [housingportal.anaheim.net/AHAStatusCheck](https://housingportal.anaheim.net/AHAStatusCheck)

As vouchers become available, pre-applications will be selected from the waiting list in the order in which they were placed by the lottery.

## TO APPLY

- **Pre-applications are accepted \*online at [www.Anaheim.net/ApplySection8](https://www.anaheim.net/ApplySection8) Applicants will receive a confirmation number when applying online.**
- Information required: names, social security numbers, and birthdates for all members of your family; home and work address, household income amounts, valid email address that you currently have access to.
- Applicants will need internet access to apply. Information about access to free computers and paper applications is below.
- To be considered for the wait list, a pre-application must be completed and submitted by 4:59 p.m. PST on **Friday, April 14, 2023.** The application is available 24 hours a day during the open enrollment period. **Applicants will be placed on the wait list based on a computerized lottery. Placement order on the wait list is not based on the order in which pre-applications are received.**
