

USING PUBLIC INTERNET COMPUTERS @ ANAHEIM PUBLIC LIBRARY



Log On

When you log on to a computer you are agreeing to comply with Anaheim Public Library's "Policy for Public Access to the Internet." Any violation will result in the loss of Internet privileges.

- A Library card number or Computer User card number is required to log on. If you do not have either of these, you will need to apply for a card, using proof of identity.
- A one-day visitor's pass is only provided to individuals whose ID indicates that they live outside Orange, Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino, and San Diego counties.
- Users with account balances of \$5.00 or more must make a payment before being allowed to use a public computer.

Limits

- Computer workstations are available on a first come, first serve basis. Specific computers may not be reserved, saved, or set aside.
- A minimum of 60 minutes per day is available at all library locations; however, the maximum amount of time each day varies by location and workstation availability.
- No more than 2 people may share the same computer, except at identified family workstations.

Users May Not . . .

- use someone else's card or ID to log onto an Internet computer. Doing so will result in the termination of the session and possible loss of Internet privileges.
- display or download any obscene, graphic material, or pornography.
- gamble or play wagering games or those games requiring plug-ins.
- download or install executable files (with the .exe, .com, .bat extension) on library computers, except as indicated under "Saving and Printing" below.
- tamper with computer configurations, hardware, headphones, software, nor upload files.

Headphones

- Users may bring in personal headphones, or purchase audio earbuds from the library.

Saving and Printing

- Save your work/files to a removable storage device. These are available for sale at the library.
- Do not save your files to the Desktop. Other users can access files on the Desktop, and these files are automatically deleted at the end of the day.
- Executable files (with the .exe, .com, .bat extension) may only be downloaded onto a user's removable storage device.

- Computer access may occasionally be unavailable due to technical issues.
- Library staff members do not provide individualized instruction for computer assistance.
- All library computers are filtered in compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act. For information about a site that is blocked, please check with staff at the Information Desk.
- The Library is not liable for any damages or injuries that result from your use of library electrical outlets or wireless services.

The Library reserves the right to terminate your Internet session at any time and will revoke computer privileges for unacceptable use.
